The petitioner seeks a writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to admit him to the Veterinary and Livestock Development Diploma Course run by respondent No.2-University.

The grievance in brief is that he was denied consideration on account of some discrepancy in the birth certificate. It is contended that the petitioner being eligible was unfairly denied admission to the course merely on account of this minor discrepancy in the certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer and the date of birth recorded in the matriculation certificate.

We notice from the facts of the case as pleaded in the petition that the petitioner filed a civil suit which was dismissed on 23.10.2017 and the appeal against the same was allowed on 22.05.2018. The present writ petition seeking a parallel remedy would thus be impermissible. We also notice that the course in question commenced in the year 2017 and it would be too late in the day to

even consider the grievance of the petitioner in the present proceedings.

We, therefore, decline interference and leave the petitioner to his alternate remedies in law that he has already availed of.

Petition stands disposed of.
