1. The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in nature of *Certiorari*, for quashing/setting aside Proclamation/Munadi dated 05.11.2008 (Annexure P-5) conducted in the area of Garha Road, Jalandhar, Punjab, whereby the petitioners were directed to remove their stalls from the side where the petitioners were carrying out their trade from last 45 to 50 years, to earn their livelihood, in the violation of the provisions of the Street Venders (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Venders) Act 2014.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that inadvertently wrong prayer has been made in the writ petition, therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh writ petition on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. The office

shall tag the present writ petition along with the fresh writ petition as and when the same is filed.
