1. In the writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for quashing the sale notice dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-21) issued by respondent-Bank, vide which the mortgaged properties in the loan account of the petitioners, have been put to sale for 14.11.2018, inspite of the fact that the petitioners have already applied for One Time Settlement, under the OTS Scheme (Annexure P-16), vide letter dated 25.06.2018 (Annexure P-17), against which vide letter dated 29.06.2018 (Annexure P-18), the Bank has replied that the same is under consideration and the amount is yet to be calculated.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that inadvertently proper and necessary parties and the supporting facts could not be incorporated in the present writ petition, therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh writ petition on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars and incorporating full details.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
