Matter relates to selection and appointment to the post of Constable in BSF, CISF, CRPF, SSB, ITBP and Assam Rifles. Grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled to be selected for the post of Constable having secured 67 marks. The respondents have filed a detailed reply in which they have specifically pointed that the last candidate in the respective discipline like BSF, CISF, CRPF, SSB, ITBP and Army Rifles, such selected candidates under UR (general category) who have secured more marks than the petitioner like in BSF-86, CISF-88, CRPF-84, SSB-86, ITBP-83 and in Assam Rifles-82. In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner has not made out a case.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
