The allegation against the petitioner is of theft of the electricity.

On 10.1.2018, the following order was passed by this Court: -

“The respondents have allegedly detected theft of electricity at the hands of the petitioner having a domestic connection. Criminal case was also registered against the petitioner, as a result of which he had applied for anticipatory bail and deposited 50% of the amount assessed. Consequently, he has been enlarged on anticipatory bail. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would deposit the remaining 50% amount but since his financial position is not good, therefore, he prays that the petitioner

may be allowed to deposit the same in installments.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that there is no procedure/rule/regulation for allowing the petitioner to pay the remaining amount of 50% by way of installments. The petitioner has also failed to show any such provision either in the rules or regulations, therefore, this Court is unable to interfere in this petition and hence, the same is hereby dismissed.
