Main Case

By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents for removal of illegal encroachments on the way leading to the field of the petitioner.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Mini Secretariat Building, Fazilka is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 03.10.2017 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Mini Secretariat Building, Fazilka to

consider and decide the representation dated 03.10.2017 (Annexure P-4) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
