JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner serving as Superintendent Grade-II with Department of Rural Development and Panchayats Punjab has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside order dated 05.12.2017 (P-5) whereby petitioner was transferred from Jandiala Guru to Naushehra Pannua against the transfer Policy for the year 2017-18 (P-1).

This Court while issuing notice of motion on 21.12.2017 passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been transferred three times within a period of four months and that too without any complaint or

administrative exigency. The children of the petitioner are school going and it is very difficult for him to maintain two houses. The impugned transfer order is contrary to the terms and conditions of the transfer policy.

Notice of motion for 28.2.2018.

Meanwhile, operation of impugned order dated 5.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) qua to petitioner shall remain stayed.”

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the Petitioner states that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the impugned transfer order dated 05.12.2017 (P-5) stands cancelled vide order dated 26.02.2018/27.02.2018.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
