PSPCL which is total independent, autonomous and legal entity than the State Government. Counsel for the petitioner to date has failed to produce any such Regularization Policy.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw both the aforesaid writ petitions to enable his clients to file fresh ones by appending the Regularization Policy duly adopted by the PSPCL.
