Petitioner was engaged as a Driver by the Panchayat Samiti, Gurdaspur on daily wages as a purely temporary arrangement. He is seeking issuance of direction in the shape of writ of Mandamus to the respondents-Authorities to give posting order to the petitioner as he has been kept on compulsory waiting period pursuant to the transfer order dated 10.07.2017 (P-7) and despite the fact that he has submitted his joining report on 13.07.2017 (P-8).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the joining of the Petitioner has been accepted and he has been allowed to join his duties as Driver at his new place of posting i.e. Block Narot Jaimal Singh on

to 31.01.2018 amounting to Rs.1,20,000/-.

Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent no.3-Amarjeet Singh, Executive Officer, Panchayat Samiti, Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot has been filed in Court conceding the aforesaid factual submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand of the parties, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
