The petitioner is employed as Driver with the respondent-department. Vide order dated 20.06.2017 (Annexure P2), he was transferred from Faridabad to Jhajjar vice Sh. Rajesh Kumar Driver No.176. However, on a writ petition filed by Rajesh Kumar i.e. CWP No.16641 of 2017, vide order dated 03.08.2017 (Annexure P3), the order of his transfer was withdrawn by the respondent-department. And the petitioner was consequently relieved from Jhajjar so as to join duties at Faridabad. Concededly, in compliance to the impugned order the petitioner as also Sh. Rajesh Kumar have joined at their previous postings. And the order being assailed in the present proceedings was passed over six months ago. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as in the matter involving similar issues, as regards transfer of the employees of the Transport Department, Haryana, this Court vide order and judgment dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P7), as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, rendered

in CWP No.24190 of 2017 (**Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others**), had issued comprehensive directions to the department to deal with similar issues, he be permitted to withdraw the petition so as to move the respondent-authorities vide a detailed representation.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty prayed for.

In the event, the petitioner makes any such representation the same shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent-authorities expeditiously and in accordance with law.
