In the present case, the petitioner has approached this Court challenging the order Annexures P-6 and P-7 by which a sum of Rs.9,99,633.41/- has been recovered from the petitioner. It has been alleged in the petition that the said recovery has been done without giving any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has given a demand notice on 18.04.2018 in which he has justified the spending of amount of Rs.9,99,633.41/- but the said notice has not been decided. He further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide his claim raised in the legal notice Annexure P-12 dated 18.04.2018.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice Annexure P-12 dated 18.04.2018, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice Annexure P-12 dated 18.04.2018 within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
