Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondent-Banks to disburse the amount of Leave Travel Concession to the petitioners and further to refund the amount already recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that despite the fact that amount towards Leave Travel Concession has been released by the employer i.e. State of Punjab, the same is not being disbursed by the Bank to the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Chief Manager (Centralized Pension Processing Cell) State Bank of Patiala now State of Bank of India, Panchkula to consider and decide the representations dated 2.8.2011, 15.4.2013 & 23.2.2015 (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Chief Manager (Centralized Pension Processing Cell) State Bank of Patiala now State of Bank of India, Panchkula to consider and decide the representations dated 2.8.2011, 15.4.2013 & 23.2.2015 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
