The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the salary amounting to ₹89697/- from respondent No. 5-Society. The prayer is for the grant of interest as well on the amount, which is due to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the legal notice, which has been given to the respondents on the same claim.

Without going into the merits of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the legal notice served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefit, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
