This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to take action on the representation dated 16.08.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Director, State Transport-cum-Managing Director, PUNBUS, Jeevan Deep Building, First Floor, Sector-17 (Near TDI Mall), Chandigarh to consider and decide the communication/representation dated 30.09.2017 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, State Transport-cum-Managing Director, PUNBUS, Jeevan Deep Building, First Floor, Sector-17 (Near TDI Mall), Chandigarh to consider and decide the communication/representation dated 30.09.2017 (Annexure P-6) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible to them or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
