By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to take into consideration the higher marks secured by the petitioner in 10+2 examination and also take into consideration the height of the petitioner and redraw the final merit list declared in February, 2017 against advertisement dated 08.10.2016. to provide/appoint the petitioner on compassionate grounds.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the justice demand notice dated 22.08.2017 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the justice demand notice dated 22.08.2017

(Annexure P-7) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
