The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents for the release of full and final service benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has raised a claim for the release of full and final service benefits including gratuity, leave encashment along with the arrears of salary and had sent a representation in this regard on 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) to respondents No.1 and 2, which was forwarded to respondent No.3 being the competent authority. He further contends that he shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction respondent No.3 to decide the representation/claim of the petitioner.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
