By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated December 01, 2017 (P-5) with further direction to respondents to refund the amount of ₹2,11,922/- along-with interest @12% per annum, which was deducted illegally, arbitrarily by the respondents from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a legal notice dated December 01, 2017 (P-5) was served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply nor any action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the legal notice (P-5) within some stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-5) and to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. However, in case petitioner feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
