Instant writ petition has been filed praying for issuing of writ of mandamus for directing the respondent authorities and particularly the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi to revise the answer key relating to a certain question paper of the Electrical Engineering Examination that had been conducted on 03.06.2018.

It is the case of the petitioner himself that similar grievance had been raised before the Apex Court by way of filing of writ petition (civil) No.952 of 2018 (Sanjay Kumar and others Vs. University Grants Commission and another) and in which the following order was passed:-

*“ We do not see any reason to interfere in the petition.
The writ petition is accordingly, dismissed. Pending
applications, if any, stand disposed of.*

*We, however, give liberty to the petitioners to make an
appropriate representation to AICTE. If the
representation is made within two weeks from today, the
AICTE is directed to consider it expeditiously.”*

Counsel states that All India Council for Technical Education was a party before the Apex Court.

Counsel prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to pursue his grievance in the light of representation dated 24.09.2018

(Annexure P-10) that is stated to have already been filed.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is observed that in case the representation dated 24.09.2018 (Annexure P-10) has already been received by All India Council for Technical Education a decision thereupon be taken expeditiously and petitioner be informed accordingly.
