In the present case, the petitioners have approached this Court seeking release of DA installments for which they are entitled for but the respondents are withholding the same without any valid justification.

In the present case, the petitioners have not filed the detailed representation alleging all the grounds, which have been made the part of the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners be given liberty to file a comprehensive representation to the respondents.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction that in case any comprehensive representation is filed by the petitioners with the respondents within a period of six weeks from today, the respondents shall decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order within a period of three months from the date of filing of the said representation.

It is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on the

merits of the case and the claim which the petitioners might make in the representation filed by them.

In case the petitioners are found entitled for any relief after the order is passed by the respondents, the same should also be released to them within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
