Petitioner Constable Jagandeep Kaur was recruited as Constable in December, 2016 with the Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana. Her services have been dispensed with pursuant to the impugned order dated 21.12.2017 (**Annexure P-4**) in the light of a revised selection list dated 19.05.2017 (**P-3**), issued by the DGP, Punjab, thereby pushing them out of the zone of appointment within the advertised vacancies.

It is contended that before issuing the impugned order (**P-4**), the principles of natural justice have not been complied with. That apart, no details of the candidates, who have superimposed in the merit list, are forthcoming.

Upon notice of motion reply dated 20.03.2018 by Dr. Sandeep Garg, ADCP Ludhiana stands filed. Along with the reply a fresh order

dated 13.03.2018 Annexure R-2 has been annexed whereby the Petitioner has been allotted Constable number of Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and has been permitted to join w.e.f. The same date.

Counsel for the parties are agreed that in view of the aforesaid circumstances, the present writ petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
