HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is widowed daughter of late Sep. Lakhwinder Singh, claiming the family pension. It has been mentioned in the petition that father of the petitioner was killed by terrorist while performing the duties in the Punjab police.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served a legal notice on 16.05.2018 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion

on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to her within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
