It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners that the order dated 29.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 is not sustainable as it is bereft of any details therein. He, however, states that the petitioners, on receipt of said notice, had sought for the copy of the complaint and the enquiry report, which were not supplied to them. Despite that, reply to the show cause notice has been submitted by the petitioners on 13.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) but till date no decision has been taken by respondent No.3.

Keeping in view the factual assertions made by counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar-respondent

No.3 to consider and decide the matter in the light of the reply, which has been filed by the petitioners, preferably by supplying them copies of the complaint and enquiry report, which have been sought by them from the said respondent, and also by affording them opportunity of hearing. Decision in the matter be taken within a period of three weeks from today and the same be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioners under the signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.
