Petitioner is seeking a writ of certiorari quashing the orders dated 17.10.2011, 23.05.2013, 16.09.2013 & 18.02.2014 (Annexures P-6, P-9, P-11 & P-12) passed by the respondents.

Vide order dated 17.10.2011 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal-respondent No.3, punishment of censure was imposed upon the petitioner. Thereafter, the Commissioner of Police, Ambala, gave a show cause notice to the petitioner under Rule 16.28 of the Punjab Police Rules, as applicable to Haryana. Petitioner gave reply to the said notice. However, vide order dated 23.05.2013 (Annexure P-9), punishment of stoppage of two annual increments with permanent effect was awarded. Against the order, petitioner filed an appeal dated 06.07.2013 (Annexure P-10) before the Director General of Police, which was dismissed vide order dated 16.09.2013 (Annexure P-11). Against the said order, a revision is pending before the Additional Chief Secretary, State of

Haryana, which has not been decided so far.

Copy of this petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

At this stage, the present petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.1 to pass a final order on the revision in accordance with law, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
