Petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 02.12.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Bhuna, order dated 27.11.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Collector, Fatehabad and order dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Commissioner Hisar Division, Hisar, on the ground that on partition, the petitioner has been assigned two separate chunks of land. In support of this contention, he placed reliance upon the Map (Annexure P-4). Counsel contends that the petitioner would be satisfied if the land is given to the petitioner in one chunk.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner and on going through the impugned orders, it is apparent that as per the partition proceedings, the possession of the parties has to keep intact. The same has been so done by the authorities.

That being so, there being no illegality in the orders passed by

the authorities below, this Court would not exercise its extraordinary powers in this writ petition as there is no patent illegality in the impugned orders. The present writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
