Learned counsel for the State submits that in pursuance of order dated 13.12.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has been promoted w.e.f. 7.10.1996 vide order dated 18.1.2018 and the consequential admissible benefits emanating from the order dated 18.7.2013 have also been released.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no interest has been paid on the delayed payment.

Considering the fact that the substantial relief has been allowed to the petitioner, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a representation with regard to the interest on the delayed payment within three months from today and the State is directed to pass an appropriate order on the representation, if so, filed, expeditiously preferably within three months of filing the such representation.
