This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.10.2018 (Annexure P-18) passed by respondent No.1, orders dated 12.10.2018 and 17.10.2018 (Annexures P-19 and 20) passed by respondent No.3 and order dated 29.09.2018 (Annexure P-15) passed by learned Presiding Officer, DRT-II, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that proceedings before Recovery Officer-respondent No.3 is fixed for 12.11.2018 and before DRAT-respondent No.1 is fixed for 28.11.2018.

4. Accordingly, the prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition at this stage to pursue the alternative remedies in accordance with law and further prayer was made that the petitioner be allowed to approach this Court again, in case need so arises.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to it, in accordance with law. Further, petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court again, if need so arises.
