The petitioner is employed as Driver with the respondent-department. Vide order dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P2), he was transferred from Faridabad to Jhajjar vice Sh. Sanjay Kumar Driver No.337. However, owing to a writ petition filed by Sanjay Kumar Driver No.337 i.e. CWP No.15988 of 2017, the respondents vide order dated 17.08.2017 (Annexure P3) re-transferred the petitioner to CBS Faridabad. And in compliance to the said order, the petitioner had since joined duties and continues to work at Faridabad to date. Ex facie, the impugned order was passed almost six months ago. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as in the matter involving similar issues, as regards transfer of the employees of the Transport Department, Haryana, this Court vide order and judgment dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P7), as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, rendered in CWP No.24190 of 2017 (**Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others**), had issued comprehensive directions to the department to deal

with similar issues, he be permitted to withdraw the petition so as to move the respondent-authorities vide a detailed representation.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty prayed for.

In the event, the petitioner makes any such representation the same shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent-authorities expeditiously and in accordance with law.
