Petitioner-Jaspal Kaur while working as Multi Purpose Health Worker (MPHW) and having the five (05) years' experience as such was sent for training to General Nursing 'A' Grade Course by the Office of Director, Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, during the period from 02.07.1990 to 01.07.1992 at Civil Hospital, Jalandhar. As per the existing policy, she was granted the leave of kind due.

The petitioner, after a delay of twenty-five (25) years, is now claiming grant of Study Leave with full financial benefits for the aforesaid training period based on the judgment passed by a Division Bench of this Court in *CWP No. 4239 of 2006*, decided on 24.09.2007. For the said relief, the petitioner is averred to have issued a Legal Notice dated 03.08.2017 (**Annexure P-2**) addressed the Director, Health and Family Welfare, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

It is not in dispute that the aforesaid legal notice seeking the relief *albeit* at such a belated stage stands issued and concededly no reply

has yet been received or action taken. Therefore, at this stage, that to at

such a belated stage, this Court is not inclined to invoke the extraordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Dismissed.
