By way of the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide his case in view of the policy (Annexure P-1), in a time-bound manner.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to learned State counsel, in the Court.

In view of the prayer made, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to treat the instant writ petition as a representation and decide the same as per law and in the light of policy (Annexure P-1), by passing a

speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
