JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

By way of the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents, inter alia, to convene the DPC for promotion to the post of Deputy Director after finalization of the seniority and after notifying the draft rules.

Heard.

As per the reply, the DPC for promotion to the post in question was convened, the eligible persons were considered and the selection has been finalized after finalization or notifying the Rules.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the proceedings of the DPC were conducted in an illegal manner and the persons who have been selected including one Jaswinder Singh Gill, allegedly a tainted person, and was not even within the zone of consideration.

Keeping in view the above, this Court feels that the purpose of filing the instant petition is fully satisfied. However, the petitioner, if so advised, is at liberty to lay challenge to the proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee in question.
