Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to regularize her services under the policy dated 11.11.2003/27.02.2004 (Annexure P-3 collectively) at par with her juniors.

Petitioner has joined the Education Department on 16.10.2002 as Sweeper. As per appointment letter dated 16.10.2002 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was appointed as Part Time Sweeper on 16.10.2002 and one Makhan Lal (respondent No.4) was appointed on 18.10.2002. His services have been regularized w.e.f. 01.04.2011 as per transfer policy dated 11.11.2003/27.02.2004 (Annexure P-3), which is applicable to the Education Department. As per this policy, if a person has worked as Part Time employee for six years, he can be regularized. The petitioner is seeking benefit of regularization at par with her juniors.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction

to the respondents to look into the matter keeping in view the judgment passed by this Court in **Balwinder Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others**, CWP-2009-2016, decided on 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-8) and taking into account the initial date of appointment of the petitioner as reflected in Annexure P-1 and thereafter, pass appropriate order for regularization of the services of the petitioner at par with her junior (respondent No.4). This order be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
