The petitioner impugns the order dated 17.1.2017 which mandates the remand to the Assistant Collector to determine the controversy between the parties after permitting them to adduce evidence in support of their case.

The grievance of the petitioner is that remand was unwarranted as the relevant material was already on record. Instead of applying their minds to the controversy, it has been re-directed to the Assistant Collector which is a process likely to impede and delay the decision. Besides the Commissioner had directed the matter to be decided in a particular way.

We do not see anything of the sort manifesting itself from the reading of the impugned order and also do not find any infirmity in the impugned order. However, while dismissing the present petition, we direct

entrusted to expedite the conclusion of the process noticing the fact that the parties have been litigating since 2017.

Hence, instant petition is hereby dismissed.
