The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Assistant Professor in Chemistry under the BC-A category.

Pursuant to the interim directions issued by this Court on December 29, 2017, she was directed to be interviewed provisionally.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced the final result of the petitioner which shows that she has obtained 63.46 marks, including the marks obtained by her in interview, whereas the last candidate who has been selected in her category has secured 69.01 marks (cut off). Thus, he submits that the petitioner has failed to qualify for selection.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
