This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to regularise the Term Loan Account and Cash Credit Limit Account of the petitioner, which has been declared NPA.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to approach the respondent-bank by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation. However, a direction may be issued to the concerned authority to decide the same in a time bound manner for regularisation of the Term Loan Account and Cash Credit Limit Account.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation giving the particulars of the amount of loan, installments and dates of payment etc. before the appropriate authority. It is directed that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioner within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order, the same shall be

decided by respondent No.1 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of next one month from the date of receipt of the representation.
