This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to award some more marks in the subject Punjabi test held on 10.12.2017 at Amritsar by respondent No.2 as some questions put in the question paper were out of syllabus and some were wrong.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is treated as representation and direction is issued to respondent No.2- Director, Education Recruitment Directorate, Punjab, Government Model Senior Secondary School (Microsoft Building), Phase 3B-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In the circumstances, the petitioners is directed to furnish a copy of the writ petition along with certified copy of the order passed within two weeks from today to respondent No.2- Director, Education Recruitment

Directorate, Punjab, Government Model Senior Secondary School (Microsoft Building), Phase 3B-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali who will treat the copy of present writ petition as representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, the competitive authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
