Case of the petitioner falls within the parameters laid down in the policy of compassionate appointment on account of his land being acquired for Deen Bandhu Sir Chotu Ram Thermal Power Project at Yamunagar. The affidavit sought by the interim direction of this Court has been placed on record by the petitioner deposing that none of his family members has any objection if he is given employment as per announcement dated 29.01.2014 (Annexure P-5). There is no other impediment in the way for grant of relief.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed and a mandamus is issued to the respondents to provide suitable job to the petitioner according to his qualifications and other eligibility conditions. The decision be taken within six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
