This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide employment under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 or to pay Daily Unemployment Allowance along with compensation as per the provisions of the Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition is treated as representation and direction is issued to respondent No.4- Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Abohar, BDPO Office, Near Tehsil Complex, Abohar, District Fazilka to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to furnish a copy of the writ petition along with certified copy of the order passed within two

weeks from today. Thereafter, respondent No.4- Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Abohar, BDPO Office, Near Tehsil Complex, Abohar, District Fazilka is directed to treat the copy of present writ petition as representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, the competitive authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not made out, then a speaking order be passed in this regard.
