This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents to decide the representation dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that at this stage she would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Director Department of Rural Development and Panchayayts, SAS Nagar to consider and decide the representation dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director Department of Rural Development and Panchayayts, SAS Nagar to consider and decide the representation

dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
