The petitioner was participating for one post of Junior Engineer (Mechanical) vide advertisement dated 27.06.2015 (Annexure P-1). He participated in the written examination on 29.11.2015 and was given roll No. 60010844. On 18.01.2017 (Annexure P-5) the result of written examination was displayed on the official website of Haryana Staff Selection Commission and also called the candidates for scrutiny of documents on 02.02.2017 and 03.02.2017. The petitioner was present in the house of his relative at Rajgarh (Rajasthan) and he became seriously ill and was shifted to Govt. Hospital Rajgarh (Rajasthan) and due to his serious condition, he could not participate in the scrutiny of documents on 02.02.2017. Copies of the medical certificates dated 02.02.2017 and 06.02.2017 have been placed on record as Annexures P-6 and P-7. On 20.02.2017, when notice of motion was issued, a direction was given that he be considered for the purpose of selection and appointment to the post of Junior Engineer. Vide order dated 19.09.2018 passed in CM No. 13649-2018, learned State counsel was directed to produce the result of the

petitioner. Today, learned counsel for the State has produced the final result of the petitioner declared on 26.02.2017 which is as under :-

And candidate with roll No. 60002400 under Physically Orthopedically handicapped category has got 125 marks. It is not the case of the respondents that there was any objection with regard to scrutiny of documents and no infirmity in the documents has been pointed out. The petitioner has got more marks than the last candidate.

Writ petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to issue appointment letter to the petitioner within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
