This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to hand over the possession of Shop No.A-46, situated at Langah Market, Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur, allotted to the petitioner in the draw of lots.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 Municipal Council, Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him in the Court.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3

Municipal Council, Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
