Present petition is against order passed in an interlocutory application. Appeal No. 6 of 2017 is pending in the court of Smt. Rachna Gupta, Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-I, Gurgaon (Annexure P9). Scope of interference in respect of interlocutory order and relief is limited under Article 226 of the Constitution. Therefore, petitioner has not made out a case.
