In the present case, the petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to release the certain arrears of retiral benefits and for the payment of interest on the delayed payments. Further, an averment has been made in the present writ petition that even the medical reimbursement, for which the petitioner was entitled for and for which the bills have already been submitted to the respondents, are not being released.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-2), for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefit(s) after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
