Heard.

Petitioner was granted parole by this Court for three weeks for house repairs vide order dated 11.9.2018 passed in CWP No.9699 of 2018. Petitioner seeks extension of parole stating that the extension of parole has been declined by Superintendent Maximum Security Jail, Nabha vide order endorsed on 6.11.2018.

I am of the view that since the parole was granted by this Court, Superintendent was right in declining the prayer for extension of the same, since, extension can only be granted by the authority which initially granted parole. Now, this Court is to consider as to whether there is any ground for extension of parole. I am of the view that the parole was granted for house repairs. If extension is entertained that would mean that for the repair of house, which will take months together, parole has to be extended from time

to time.

The Court considered the case of the petitioner for house repairs and thereafter only three weeks parole was granted to the petitioner to make arrangements for the house repairs. No ground is made out to grant extension of parole.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
