Prayer made by way of Public Interest Litigation under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for directions to the respondents to ensure that all the National Highways/State Highways/railway tracks falling in the State of Haryana not be blocked by the agitators and immediate action be taken against the agitators as per the provisions of National Highway Act, 1956. Further prayer has been made to direct respondents to take all necessary actions to ensure that free flow of

public at large is not stopped, roads are not jammed, railway tracks are not blocked and Government and other properties are not damaged.

2. Petitioner who appears in person, has submitted that neither in November, 2017 any untoward incident happened nor on 18.02.2018, when the Balidan Divas was held by the respondent No.7. It was stated that in view thereof the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
