Present writ petition for issuing directions to the respondents to release all the retiral benefits to him along with interest at the rate of 12%.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner superannuated from services on 25.01.2018, but he has not been given retiral benefits till date and no disciplinary proceedings are pending against the petitioner. Learned counsel further contended that petitioner got issued legal notice dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P7), but the same has not been decided till now by the respondents and his grievance would be redressed if the said legal notice is decided within a stipulated time frame.

On asking of the Court, Mrs. Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. A complete copy of paper-book be provided to her during the course of the

day.

In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to the respondents to look into legal notice dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P7) and take the required decision thereon, expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
