This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of direction to the official respondents to take action upon order/ letter dated 22.8.2016 (Annexure P-8) issued by the office of respondent No.3 in pursuance of the application -cum-legal notice dated 4.8.2016 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner regarding conducting enquiry into the matter of having two ration cards and being registered as a voter at two different places/ addresses by the Sarpanch of village Singhpura.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.4- Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra to consider and decide the application -cum-legal notice dated 4.8.2016 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Kapil Bansal, DAG, Haryana

accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him in the Court.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra to consider and decide application -cum- legal notice dated 4.8.2016 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
