By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 30.06.2014 (P-3).

2. At the very outset of arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the parties that instant petition has rendered infructuous as the representation dated 30.06.2014 (P-3) has already been dealt with and disposed of by the respondents vide order dated November 13, 2017.

3. In view of above, instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedied available under law, if he is still aggrieved by the order passed by the respondents.
