By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take action and ensure impartial investigation on the representation dated 26.07.2017 (Annexure P-5 colly.) given against respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 26.07.2017 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur to consider and decide the representation dated 26.07.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on

consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
