This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the impugned letter dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) issued by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that on receipt of Annexure P-5 dated 20.09.2018, the petitioner has not approached the respondent No.2. However, it was stated that vide annexure P-3 dated 25.07.2018, the respondent-bank was informed that the entire loan has been cleared.

3. Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the bank at the first instance raising all the pleas as sought to be raised in the present writ petition. However, it was prayed that a time bound direction be given to the respondents to decide the same.

4. After perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioners to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition before respondent No.2. It is directed that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioners within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order, the same shall be decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners within a period of next one month from the date of receipt of the representation.
