Two Petitioners Munish Devi and Jasveer Kaur were seeking a Mandamus directing the Elementary Education Department, Punjab for offering them appointment to the post of ETT teachers under the reserved category of Scheduled Caste/Backward Class based on their merit against the advertisement dated 09.11.2015.

Upon notice reply on behalf of the respondents stands filed.

On one of the previous date of hearing, Munish Devi-petitioner no.1 had already withdrawn her claim in the writ petition based on the fact that she had been offered appointment.

At the time of hearing today, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition on behalf of the remaining petitioner no.2-Jasveer Kaur as she is also stated to have been offered

appointment as ETT teacher.

In view of the statement made by learned Counsel for the petitioner at bar, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.
